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**ORDER**

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**UPON** the disclosure to the Claimant and the Tribunal by the Respondents of documentation ("Documentation", defined below) revealing the names of private individuals ("Relevant Persons", defined below)

**AND UPON** that Documentation forming part of the evidence to be considered at the trial of the Claimant's claim

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. There shall be no disclosure, publication or reporting of any information which:
  - 1.1. Discloses a Relevant Person's (as defined below) identity (including any description or image capable of identifying a Relevant Person); and/or
  - 1.2. Has the effect of disclosing a Relevant Person's identity, or contributing to such disclosure, and which the person responsible for the disclosure or publication knows or suspects will have that effect.
2. Paragraph 1 above binds any and all individuals and/or legal persons (whether acting by themselves; or by their servants or agents; or by their

directors or officers; or in any other way) but does not prohibit any disclosure to:

- 2.1. The Tribunal;
  - 2.2. The Parties and their legal representatives;
  - 2.3. A witness, for the purpose of their giving evidence; or,
  - 2.4. Counsel to the Tribunal.
3. A “*Relevant Person*” is a private individual and not an employee of the Respondents:
- 3.1. About whom the Respondents and/or their officers or employees recorded and/or transmitted information, pursuant to authorisations granted under the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 (RIPA);
  - 3.2. Who is, as a consequence of those authorisations, identified in Documentation;
  - 3.3. Who is not giving evidence in these proceedings by way of a witness statement to the Tribunal in their true identity.
4. “*Documentation*” is:
- 4.1. Internal documents created by the Respondents and/or their officers or employees pursuant to authorisations granted under RIPA; and
  - 4.2. Disclosed by the Respondents to the Claimant and the Tribunal for the purposes of the resolution of this claim.
5. A “*Relevant Person*” also includes:
- 5.1. For the avoidance of doubt, any person giving evidence in these proceedings by way of a witness statement to the Tribunal under a pseudonym (but for the avoidance of any doubt, the pseudonym is not to be taken as that person’s “*true identity*” for the purposes of the prohibition on disclosure or publication in paragraph 1 above).

- 5.2. The two individuals named in paragraph 6 of Lisa's supplemental statement dated 8 April 2021.
6. Any person affected by this Order may apply, on notice to the Parties, to have it varied or set aside.
